There are some issues with data entry into Manage to Win (MTW) that I want to bring to your attention. Please forward this information onto your teams.

Any penalty of 5 minutes in duration is a major penalty and will also include a GM. Both the major penalty and the GM must be recorded in MTW as 5 minutes for the specific offence and 10 minutes for the GM. Even if the GM does not appear on the game sheet it is a time keeper/officials error and it is automatic with the 5 minute major call. The call must be entered against the guilty party and not to the player who actually served the penalty.

Any Checking from Behind (CFB) minor also includes a GM50. Both of these must be recorded in MTW as 2 minutes CFB and 10 Minutes GM50.

Any minor penalty for Checking to The Head (CTH) also includes a 10 minute M71 call. This is mandatory with this call and both the 2 minute minor and the 10 minutes for the M71 must be entered in MTW.

Any misconduct (M) Game Misconduct (GMXX) or any Gross Misconduct (GRMXX) must be recorded as 10 minutes.

Any Match Penalty (MPXX) must be recorded as 5 minutes.

All calls for Too Many Men (TMM) sorry there is no gender correct code for female hockey will be entered against the Bench and not against the player who sits the minor penalty call. This same principle applies to Bench Minor (BM) calls as well, however there is one little glitch in this one in that a player can be assessed a BM. If a player is in fact issued a BM then she should be shown as the one to get credited with the 2 minutes and not the bench.
