**Program Overview:**

A full season development program for girls who love the game and are ready to take part in the excitement, challenge and intensity of playing rep level hockey. The program will focus on developing individual technical skills and individual tactics to prepare the girls for elite level hockey in following years.

**Program Details:**

- Provide a fun learning environment built on positive reinforcement, enthusiasm and enjoyment of hockey
- Advanced skills development program to prepare players for success at a high level of rep hockey in future years
- Early “training camp”, 3 times per week in September followed by a weekly practice starting October
- Maximum participation in Sharks sponsored power skating sessions currently run by Gery Othman on bi-weekly basis.
- Supplemental practice to be held on alternating weeks to power skating
- Team funded goaltender instruction
- Approx 4 tournaments including 1 over night
- Entry to qualify for Provincial Championships in April
- Min **100hrs** of ice time including games and practices
- Alternative training facilities such as Puck Hogs or Pro Shots will be considered as time and budget allow
